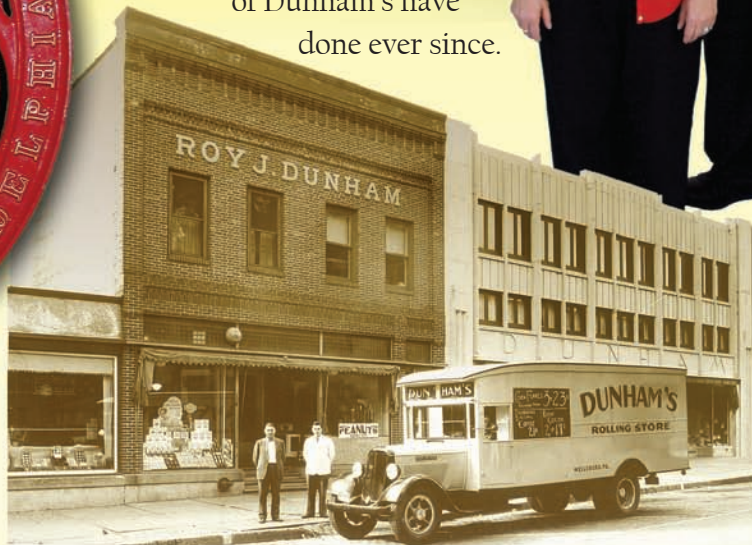




It was March 19, 1905 and the dirt streets of Wellsboro were awash with puddles from an early rainy spell. Mud-caked carriage wheels splashed dirty water on hitching posts and wooden sidewalks. It wasn't the ideal day to take over ownership of a store on Main Street. But Roy and Fannie Dunham had a dream, and dreams don't wait for good weather.

The dream began as a half-interest in a small grocery store. Early 20<sup>th</sup> Century entrepreneurs, Roy and Fannie soon added dry goods to their grocery section. When the building burned in 1913, it wasn't a call to defeat, but a reason to purchase additional space, rebuild and expand to serve community needs. It's what four generations of Dunham's have done ever since.

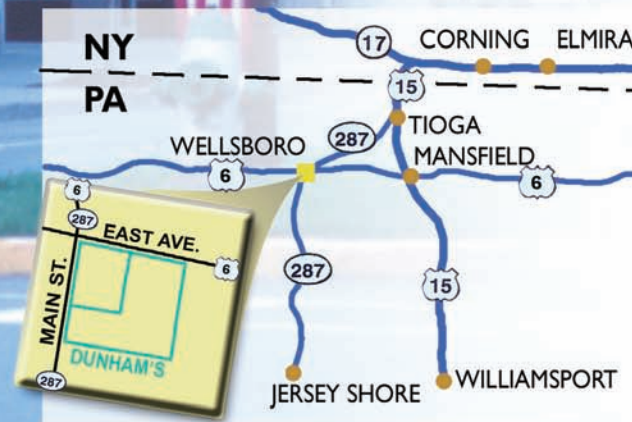
